So when Jasper begs for his help, Charly eagerly steals into the night by his side, terribly afraid but desperate to impress. Jasper takes him through town and to a secret glade in the bush, and it's there that Charly bears witness to Jasper's horrible discovery. With this secret like a brick in his belly [...] Charlie learns to discern the truth from the myth, and why white lies creep like a curse.¹
